LONG BEACH READ BY NINE

OVERVIEW:

The Rotary Club of Long Beach holds an annual fundraiser where members and guests make donations to the Long Beach Rotary Charitable Foundation for our Reading by Nine Program. This program provides funding and children’s books to Long Beach area libraries, schools, teachers, childcare centers, nonprofits and other literacy organizations that promote early reading and literacy. The goal of our program is to foster and promote reading at grade level by age 9.

2018-20189 LITERACY MINI-GRANTS FOR NONPROFITS:

The Reading by Nine program through the Long Beach Rotary Charitable Foundation will be providing funding to support local literacy projects run by area libraries, childcare centers, nonprofits and other organizations through a grant program of the Rotary Charitable Foundation. This year we have increased the amount of funds available to local non-profit literacy programs to \$9,000, with not to exceed \$2,500 per grant. Non-Profit Organizations may apply for literacy grants from \$500 - \$2,500 for innovative and creative reading and/or literacy programs that support the goals of Reading by 9. Grants will be awarded by April 2019 and may be used to purchase books, audio books, teacher resources and workbooks directly from the Scholastic Store at Schloastic.com or to pay for other literacy program materials and costs as needed and outlined in a proposal below. Grant recipients who are processing Scholastic orders must do so with the Rotary Club of Long Beach by May 1, 2019.

Applications will be judged by the Long Beach Rotary Literacy Committee and approved by the Long Beach Rotary Charitable Foundation based on creativity, uniqueness and emphasis on preparing students to be ready to read at grade level by age 9. Grant recipients are requested to submit a one-page report, detailing how the grant funds were utilized and the outcome or benefits of the awarded program at any time up to March 1, 2020 via the email address below to the Long Beach Rotary Charitable Foundation. Recipients of Long Beach Rotary Nonprofit Literacy Program grants may be invited to present their project at a Rotary Club of Long Beach luncheon.
